So now your scene is set – Wall Street, NYC, investment banking. And to be honest, we couldn't put it down.

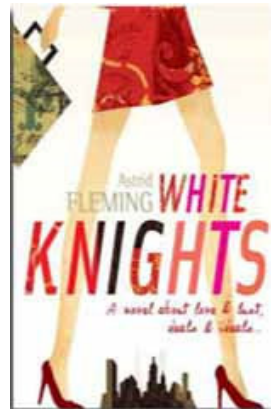
